Corpus Christi

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ



In a couple of weeks, on June the 20th, we will be celebrating the Feast of Corpus Christi at our Sunday Liturgy of the Eucharist. It is a Catholic liturgical solemnity that celebrates the real presence of the body and blood of Jesus Christ.

Although Holy Thursday, commemorating the Last Supper, is the Eucharistic feast, it could not be celebrated with the joy needing to be expressed because of its setting with Good Friday following. The feast of Corpus Christi was established by Pope Urban IV to create a feast focused solely on the Holy Eucharist emphasizing the joy of the Eucharist being the body and blood of Jesus Christ. An early element in Corpus Christi devotions emphasizing Christ's real Eucharistic presence was the Eucharistic procession to three or four simple altars set up in various places with Benediction at each. It was Pope Urban IV who also commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas, the great Dominican scholar, to compose liturgical texts for the feast.

Even though we will not be celebrating with a procession, we will commemorate the Solemnity at our Sunday Liturgy. I remember when I had not yet received First Communion, going out into the pasture early in the morning with my dad, walking barefoot on the dewy grass, to gather wild flowers for my older sister who would be scattering them in the Corpus Christi procession at church that morning. I looked forward to the day when I would scatter flowers and wear my First Communion dress again. As fate would have it, 2 years later when it was my turn, I had a bad case of German measles on that feast! I never got to scatter flowers, but in my high school days, while belonging to the CYO in my parish, I was privileged to help set up and decorate the 3 outdoor simple altars on the church campus for the procession.

The pictures on this page are similar to what the procession may have looked like; the altar boys leading with the censer (thurible), the First Communicants strewing a carpet of flowers in the pathway before the canopy under which the priest was carrying the Blessed Sacrament enthroned in a monstrance, with the rest of the congregation following. The

procession stopped at each of the altars where we sang hymns, had some prayers and blessings, and concluded with full Benediction at the third altar.

In some parishes the procession was held in the church or in the streets of the city. My most recent experience of the procession in the streets, with Benediction only once at the end, was in the early 2000's while ministering in Abilene, TX. This Corpus Christi procession is still encouraged, but the number of Benedictions is not specified.

Catholic Diocese of Dodge City

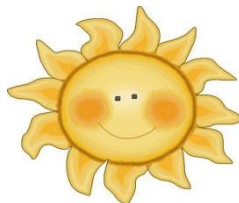

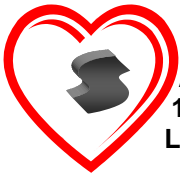


GAME DAY

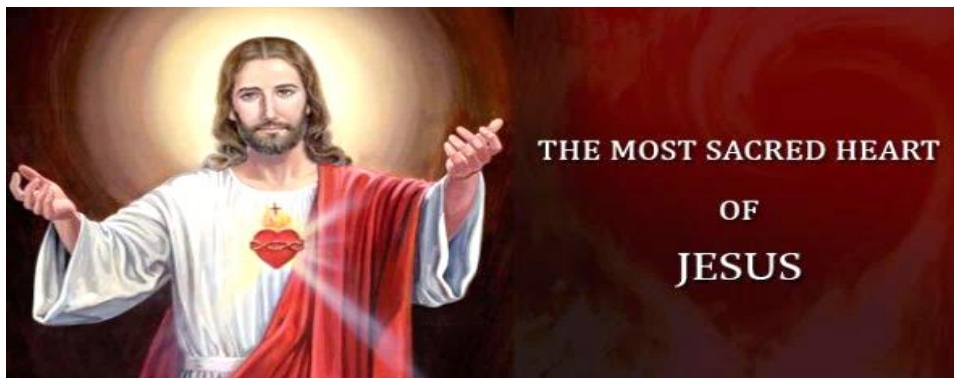
