Training for Extraordinary Ministers of Communion (Eucharistic Ministers) and Ministers of the Word (Lectors) Just as anyone in a professional position keeps themselves updated and informed in their profession, so we who are involved in any of the parish liturgical ministries need to keep ourselves renewed and updated. The Pastoral Council Bylaws state that the Adult Religious Formation Commission "provides an initial and compulsory on-going training program for liturgical ministers." Therefore, all who are presently Eucharistic Ministers or Lectors, all who have been invited to answer the call to either of these ministries, are encouraged and expected to attend one of these training sessions. If these dates are not compatible with your time, please inform the parish office. With this in mind, the ARF Commission has set the following dates for the training of:

Extraordinary Ministers of Communion: Sunday, Sept. 15th, 1:30 to 4:30, or Saturday, Sept. 21st, 9:00 to Noon.

Ministers of the Word: Sunday, September 22nd, 1:30 to 3:30, or Saturday September 28th, 9:00 to 11:00.
