Extraordinary Eucharistic Minister's and Lector's experience Renewal Time for their ministries at Sacred Heart Parish

Fr. Warren and the Adult Religious Formation Commission, who spent many hours making preparations for the recent renewal of our liturgical ministers, express our sincere gratitude for all those who took advantage of renewing themselves in the ministries of Eucharistic Minister and Lector. These will be commissioned after approval by the Bishop. Oh yes, there were sighs and groaning about the time involved, but let us share some of the evaluations of the participants. These are some of the responses to the question, ***"What did you find beneficial in the session?"*** prayerful conversation; sharing with others in small groups; "I first thought '3 hours for this?' – now I am very grateful for this time of reflection." "I actually found all parts to be beneficial"; the reminder of importance of Community; worship; so much nice reflection, prayer, and discussion; very uplifting; getting to know the other ministers better; recap of the respect for the Body and Blood of Christ; Father's remarks about the Precious Blood verses the wine; how to dress for these important ministries; learning about who is coming up in your line for Eucharist; going over the changes we will be making in these ministries; "It didn't seem like 3 hours"! **Beginning in October, you will notice some changes in the procedure of distributing communion. The number of Eucharistic Ministers is reduced to 4 instead of 6 (2 cups only). Servers will come to communion from their pew with the congregation.**
