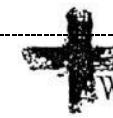

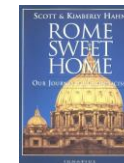

US BISHOPS, CRS (Catholic Relief Services) receive over \$50M for aid to typhoon victims. In the two months following Typhoon Haiyan, special collections undertaken by bishops in the United States raised "\$7.2 million for humanitarian relief and church rebuilding and \$2.9 million strictly for humanitarian relief," according to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. In all, Catholic Relief Services, the US bishops' international relief and development agency, has received "over \$50 million in donations, including \$27 million from bishops and dioceses." The typhoon, the deadliest in the history of the Philippines, left over 1,600 dead and 1,700 missing and caused \$1.5 billion in damage. Thank you to Sacred Heart and Saint Bernard parishes who have contributed to this cause!
