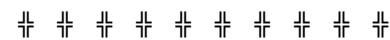

FEASIBILITY STUDY UPDATE The representative from Mark Davy & Associates returned to Larned on Monday evening, September 22 and gave the project committee an oral presentation of the results of their study, as well as the report in written form. The survey showed strong support to move in the direction of building a new parish center. They believe we can raise between \$400,000 and \$500,000 for this project. Following the meeting we had one member step forward to volunteer his time to chair a capital campaign committee. We also had someone step forward to volunteer his time to chair a building committee. These volunteers need a little bit of time to do some basic planning and organizing. In the near future we will have another Town Hall Meeting, asking parishioners to come and offer their thoughts regarding the construction of a new building.
