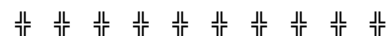

QUESTIONS ABOUT THE PROPOSED CHAPEL IN THE RELIGIOUS FORMATION AND PARISH CENTER

The Building Committee has been asked if the proposed chapel in the new building would be built in such a way so to serve as an Adoration Chapel. After consultation with parishes in our diocese that offer Perpetual Adoration, we have been made aware that it can take as many as 2,000 Catholic households to make Perpetual Adoration a possibility. Dodge City, Garden City and Liberal currently offer Perpetual Adoration. Great Bend has not been able to sustain Adoration for seven days a week, 24 hours a day, even with their large number of households; therefore they offer Adoration on a modified schedule. With our smaller number of households we do not foresee Perpetual Adoration happening at Sacred Heart unless Larned would undergo a radical population growth. The question has also been asked if the chapel would be built in such a way as to accommodate 24 hour access via a combination keypad lock. Due to construction costs, heating and cooling, security and safety concerns of making part of the building accessible around the clock, the building plan does not provide for a separate outside entrance to the chapel.
