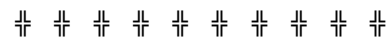

HEARTLAND CENTER FOR SPIRITUALITY will be having a Theology Institute on Integral Ecology July 21-25. Linda Gibler, OP will present on Pope Francis' encyclical, *Laudato Si'*. In the encyclical Pope Francis call for a renewed exploration of what it means to be human in relationship to a suffering planet. In this Theological Institute, we will explore what the Earth, *Laudato Si'*, and our faith tradition might be asking for us. In our days together, we will take an ecological look at key passages in the Bible, explore cosmocentric perspectives on Sacraments, Prayer, and Preaching, and ask ourselves how our gifts and charisms (personal and communal) call us to respond to an "Integral ecology." Linda, A Dominican Sister of Houston, is the Associate Academic Dean of the Oblate School of Theology in San Antonio.
